SPECIFIC TO THE POSITION:

The Deputy Chief Technology Officer position shall be responsible for information technology planning, coordination, budgeting, technical architecture, and management of large-scale information technology operations and initiatives, in a single area of interest, as determined by the Chief Technology Officer. This position shall be responsible for OIT's Cloud Operations Division. As a member of the Senior Leadership Team, responsible for assisting in the direction, implementation, and support of the State's technical vision, in addition to leading assigned aspects of the organization's technology development and day-to-day operations. Under direction of the Chief Operating Officer, exercises managerial oversight over the State's Data Centers & Facilities, Co-Location Services, and Managed Hosting Services (including mainframe, distributed, private / public / hybrid cloud).

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS:

MUST POSSESS THE FOLLOWING KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES TO BE CONSIDERED. Knowledge of the tools and techniques to manage integration, scope, time, cost, quality, human resources, vendors, communication, risk, and procurement.

Demonstrated knowledge and experience managing enterprise class data centers and managed hosting environments. Experience with cloud and hybrid-cloud architectures. Familiarity with mainframe platforms / technologies.

Demonstrated management skills and leadership capabilities. Ability to lead and facilitate multiple activities and resources; strong analytical and strategy development capabilities; effective problem solving and communication skills; ability to organize and structure activities; ability to grasp strategic concepts; ability to manage employees; ability to review and interpret contracts; ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with all levels of management and co-workers.

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's Degree.

EXPERIENCE: Six (6) years of experience managing a multi-platform IT Infrastructure environment. Three (3) years of the required experience shall have been in a supervisory capacity, one (1) year of which involved supervising second-line supervisors or middle managers.

SUBSTITUTIONS

Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute four (4) years of additional nonsupervisory experience of the type indicated in the experience section.

FOR NON-U.S. CITIZENS AND/OR FOREIGN DEGREES:

AUTHORIZATION TO WORK: U.S. Citizenship is not required. Selected candidate must be authorized to work in the U.S. according to Department of Homeland Security, U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services regulations.

RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS: In accordance with the New Jersey First Act, [N.J.S.A. 52:14-7 \(L. 2011, Chapter 70\)](#), effective September 1, 2011 all employees must reside in the State of New Jersey unless exempted under the law. If you do not live in New Jersey, you have one year after you begin employment to relocate your residence to New Jersey. Employees who fail to meet the residency requirements or obtain an exemption will be removed from employment.

As a condition of employment with NJOIT a background inquiry will be conducted.


